

Council Meeting
October 3, 2017

Council Present: Mayor Josh Acker, Jaime Odell, John Bigart III, and Salinas Bartel. Marvin Garding was absent.

A motion was made by Salinas seconded by John to approve the September 5, 2017 budget minutes with correction. All were in favor.

A motion was made by Jaime seconded by John to approve the September 5, 2017 minutes with correction. All were in favor.

A motion was made by John seconded by Salinas to approve the claims from check number 15161 through 15190 totaling \$27,042.12. All were in favor.

Water Sewer: James Claxton was at the meeting. The department is running well. Donna Coburn wanted to know who watches the cameras when James is not available. The backup person would check them if there was a problem.

Fire Department: Chief Joe Calnan was not at the meeting.

Sheriff Department: Deputy Manning was in for the Sheriff. He is having the deputies contact him when they are in Alberton and he writes it down on the patrol log. He is also making sure he is here more often.

County Planner: Tim Read was not at the meeting.

New Business:

Library: Connie Acker the librarian discussed some ideas on the library. She would like to move the desk from the children's area and put up some shelves. She would also like to paint the library. The town would purchase the paint and supply the labor.

Resolution 285: The clerk explained the resolution. This is to request that our funds from HB473 be reserved. HB473 is the Bridge and Road Safety Accountability Act. The next step is to determine how the town wants to spend the money. After further discussion John made a motion seconded by Jaime to adopt the resolution. All were in favor.

Loreen Green updated on the recycling bin. They have joined the Mineral County Economic Development Council and are running under their 501c. The bin is back at the
