

Council Meeting
October 6, 2020

Council Present: Mayor John Bigart III, Jaime Odell, Marvin Garding, Anna LeDuc and Joe Hanson.

Budget Hearing Minutes: The Clerk read the minutes. Jaime made a motion seconded by Marvin to approve the budget hearing minutes as read. All were in favor.

Minutes: The Clerk read the minutes. A motion was made by Jaime seconded by Anna to approve the September 1, 2020 minutes as read. All were in favor.

Claims: The claims were discussed. A motion was made by Marvin seconded by Jaime to pay the claims from check number 15912 through 15942 in the amount of \$32,089.31. All were in favor.

The Council received and reviewed the bank reconciliation and cash report. They have access at the Expenditure to Budget and Revenue to Budget financial reports.

Water Sewer: James Claxton was not at the meeting. The Mayor stated that the water project is complete. The system is running good.

Fire Department: Chief Joe Calnan was not at the meeting.

Sheriff Department: Undersheriff Wayne Cashman was at the meeting. He updated on the department. All is good. Marilyn McEwen wanted to know about the speeding on Railroad and Adams. The Mayor updated on the new radar speed signs that the town has. We are currently waiting for the encroachment permit from the highway department. The department will get more deputies out here.

The contract will be on next month's agenda

County Planner: Andy Short was not at the meeting.

Old Business

HB473 – Resolution 305: This resolution will allow the town to roll over our current gas tax money from HB473 to next year for a bigger project. After discussion Anna made a motion seconded by Marvin to approve resolution 305. All were in favor.

New Business

PoBoys Food Truck Parking: Billy Cooper owns Puffy's PoBoys food truck and would like to park it in the parking lot for about a month. The Mayor suggested that this could open a problem for the town. Jaime also thought this might set a precedent for future issues. We will not allow this at this time. The Mayor will let Billy Cooper know.

Christmas Train Light: The Clerk showed the council and those present a picture of a train light. After discussion Jaime made a motion seconded by Anna to purchase the light for \$2,790.00. Jaime, Marvin, and Anna voted yes; Joe voted no. The motion carried.

Clerk Notes: The Clerk updated the council on the library flooring. Per Connie Acker it looks like the floor will be taken up by the middle of October. If all goes well, they will not need to remove the asbestos. We would like to change the bulbs on the Christmas lights soon. After discussion regarding the requirement to wear masks now it was decided to wait until the first Saturday in November.

Public Comment:

Laura Acker from the PEAK foundation updated on the path in the park. They will need an encroachment permit from the DOT for part of the path and part of the east end of the skatepark. We will put this on next month's agenda. She also stated that the event at the Brovold orchard last week was awesome.

Marvin made a motion seconded by Jaime to adjourn.
