

Council Meeting

Council Present: Mayor Josh Acker, John Bigart III, Jaime Odell, Marvin Garding and Salinas Bartel.

A motion was made by Jaime seconded by Marvin to approve the February 7, 2017 minutes with correction. All were in favor.

A motion was made by John seconded by Salinas to approve the claims from check number 15009 through 15027 totaling \$17,295.43. All were in favor.

**Water Sewer:** James Claxton was at the meeting. He updated on what was happening in the department. There is not much going on now. The Great Falls trip that he and Doug Lausch took was not as good as they had expected. The test was not what they had been studying for. There are more classes coming up.

**Fire Department:** Chief Joe Calnan was not at the meeting.

**Sheriff Department:** Sheriff Bauer was not at the meeting. Deputy Allard was at the meeting. He updated on the department. There is not much going on now.

**Old Business:**

**PEAK Tennis Court Update:** Amy Lommen from the PEAK Foundation was at the meeting to update on the progress of the tennis court. They conducted a survey with parents and kids and the results were a rock climbing wall, Skateboard Park, and climbing ropes. They found out that a climbing wall and climbing ropes needed supervision so they decided not to do those. They are currently trying to obtain grants and fund raising. They would like to know if there is any funding that the town could provide. The town has money in a spectator fund that is for the sole purpose of recreational activities that benefit spectators. The west tennis court will be rebuilt and the east tennis court will be where the skate board park will be. They would like permission to seek further research on the skate board park, the town sees no problem with them going forward. They will keep the town posted. They are holding a mascaraed ball on April 22<sup>nd</sup> at the White Raven events center. Tickets will be \$30.00 for a single and \$50.00 for a couple.

**New Business:**

The Mayor informed those present that the town had received a bill from Sandra Fairbank for sewer work on her property at 102 5<sup>th</sup> St. for \$6,500.00 plus. She is wanting the town to pay for repairs that she made to her sewer line. She feels that when the town repaired part of the line that they caused her line to have problems. After discussion John

suggested sending a letter to Sandra stating that the town does not feel responsible for her sewer issues and that we will dig up our line in the spring and inspect it then.

**Playground:** The Mayor, Jaime, Salinas and Doug looked over the area by the tires for placing the slide and swings this spring. This area has dead grass because of the sprinklers and won't be affect the folf course.

**Public Comment:**

The clerk informed those present on the upcoming vaccination clinic at the town office on Saturday, April 8<sup>th</sup> from 1pm to 5pm.

Also, the upcoming election for Council and Mayor. The first day to file is April 20<sup>th</sup> and the last day is June 19<sup>th</sup>. The town has two 2 year terms, two 4 year terms and the Mayor is a 4 year term.
