

Council Meeting
December 6, 2016

Council Present: Mayor Josh Acker, John Bigart III, Jaime Odell and Marvin Garding.

A motion was made by John seconded by Jaime to approve the November 1, 2016 minutes as read. All were in favor.

A motion was made by John seconded by Marvin to approve the claims from check number 14954 through 14969 totaling \$13,237.09. All were in favor.

The current resident deputy and the new deputy are residing at Station 8 until they find adequate housing. The Sheriff would like to discontinue doing the monthly patrol hour log. After discussion it was decided that they could discontinue the monthly patrol log for as long as we have a resident deputy. If we lose our resident deputy they will start the log again.

County Planner: Tim Read was at the meeting. There is a updated subdivision application page that they are going to update.

Old Business:

First Reading of Ordinance 2-2-1: The Mayor read the ordinance regarding council pay increase to \$40.00 per month. John made a motion seconded by Jaime to accept the first read of ordinance 2-2-1. All were in favor. The final read will be January 3, 2017.

New Business:

Tobacco Free Parks: Barb Jasper from the Mineral County Health Department was at the meeting. She had information on tobacco free parks. She would like the town to participate in the tobacco free parks movement. There is no enforcement from law enforcement. The town will look into getting some signs for the area at the baseball field and possibly also by the tennis courts. The Clerk will contact Brenda in Superior to see what their signs look like and go from there.

The Mayor stated that the school has the playground equipment back and they will hold it for the town until spring. We will look at finding a place for it sometime in March.
