Council Present: Mayor John Bigart III, Sharon Briggs, and Joe Hanson.

We have ordered a replacement and hopefully it will be here soon. He has been monitoring the situation. Michael Sabatini who lives at 104 Parkway drive wanted to know what was being done. When asked if he had any sewage in his home, he stated no. He was only concerned about his 4-year-old playing outside. We will have one or two repaired this spring. There was an issue on Rosehill Lane, a outside water faucet had frozen and broke. He was able to turn the water off in the house. Sharon wanted to know if the town was part of Montana Rural Water. The Clerk mentioned that yes, we are, and they are a wonderful help.

Fire Department: Chief Joe Calnan was not at the meeting.

Sheriff Department: Sheriff Toth was not at the meeting.

County Planner: Andy Short was not at the meeting.

<u>Clerks Notes</u>: The Clerk updated on the ARPA funds from the county. The information has been sent to the county. The town had received a partial check from the insurance company for the wind damage at the center. We will replace the roof in the spring.

Public Comment:

Bob Summerfield was at the meeting. He wants to move forward with the variance request for a well and septic on the property. The Clerk will send him a variance application to fill out and return. We will put this on next months agenda for a first notice.

Sharon stated that she thought that Marvin was doing a fine job.

Marvin stated that the owner at 100 Parkway Drive would like to see the manhole in front of his house moved. He will get with an engineer and see if that can be done.
